

Health Accounts of Haryana

The findings and policy implications of Haryana's first Health Accounts (HA) estimation, for fiscal year April 2014 through March 2015, have been compiled and presented in the form of a report. The current workshop was conducted with an objective to disseminate the findings of this report with National and state stakeholders, so as to bring to use in making policy decisions. The workshop also aimed at coming up with recommendations for future research, strategy formulation and establishing a monitoring framework, after receiving inputs from the distinguished experts.
